

FIMOair basic – Flower medallions



Country house flair in your home - Create a natural decoration with dried flowers and FIMOair basic.

The flower medallions are quick and easy to make and are also great to do with children!

Step-by-step tutorial



1

Cut off approx. 1/3 of a block of FIMOair basic with a knife. Roll the FIMOair out with an acrylic roller on a piece of baking paper until it is approx. 5 mm thick.

Then place the flowers on the FIMOair with enough space between them and carefully press them into the modelling clay. Use the acrylic roller again to do this and carefully roll over the flowers until they have been firmly pressed into the clay.

Tip: this DIY art works best with dried flowers and leaves.

Take a small round cutter of your choice and cut out the medallions. The flower should always be in the middle.

To finish off, make a hole at the top edge of the medallion so you can thread the string through later. Use the bead piercing needles for this. Allow the medallions to air dry for at least one day at room temperature.
